Introduction

What is a Public file?

The purpose of the Public File is to provide a snapshot of localness and musical output and acts as a signpost to features and characteristics of a station.

Mansfield 103.2 is the local radio station for Mansfield, Ashfield and Bolsover and every local commercial station across the UK has requirements in respect of its local content and music.

The Public File is designed to give you a better understanding of the radio station's output

The Public File is also available in hard copy by post upon request by any member of the public, and serves as one indicator of each station's output.

Comments on its contents should be made to the station or to the industry regulator Ofcom.

It's important to us, and Ofcom, that listeners understand how the radio station works and what output we promise to provide.

3.2 News Content

Mansfield 103.2 is part of the Independent Radio News Network and is licensed to use news material provided by the service and also run national news bulletins provided by IRN satellite feed. This is currently the Sky News service.

Traffic and Travel bulletins are provided between 6am – 10am and 3pm-6pm Monday to Friday with additional updates when needed though the day. We also provide a weekend travel service.

3.3 The News Team

We have 3 Broadcast Journalists in our team which is headed by Managing Director and News Editor Tony Delahunty.

4.2 The Mansfield 103.2 Playlist

Currently Mansfield 103.2 has over 5000 songs on its music database with approximately 600 of those currently in regular rotation.

The new music is put onto our play list using a **CURRENTS** and **RECURRENTS** system.

CURRENTS are radio station's newest songs and at the moment there are 16 in rotation. The updated list can be found on our website – www.mansfield103.co.uk

RECURRENTS which mainly features big songs from the last 5 years has just over 170 in rotation.

We do allow listeners to request songs, most notably during our Workplace Requests sponsored feature that runs every weekday from 12pm – 1pm. Through our **Interactive Weekend** feature listeners are also invited to request some of the music between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays and Sundays. SECTION 5 : RECENT PROGRAMME AND/OR NEWS HIGHLIGHTS



Mansfield 103.2 plays its part in the local community by helping out where it can.

Each year we team up with local businesses to raise money for the Kings Mill Hospital Children's ward. We have helped to raise over £15,000 so far with the money going to buy much needed toys and equipment for the ward.

The station has also taken part in and helped promote the Clumber Park memory walk for the Alzheimer's Society for the last few years.

We've also been part of many major local events, in September 2017 we covered the Tour Of Britain cycle race which came to Mansfield, we also put together an overnight 'election special' focusing on our local General Election counts and we were once again part of the team that helped to organise and put on the Mansfield Christmas Lights Switch On which was attended by thousands of local people.

The radio station has twice been nominated in the Small Station of the Year category at the Arqiva Awards and was given a mayoral commendation by Mansfield District Council for it's fundraising work.

SECTION 6 : HOW TO COMPLAIN



If you are a listener and you are unhappy with any part of our broadcasting you can make a formal complaint by either contacting the station direct or going through OFCOM

6.1 To The Radio Station

The best way to make a formal complaint directly to the radio station is to do so in writing to Mansfield 103.2's Managing Director.

If you are upset about a particular presenter's conduct, programme (or part of a programme) or a news story please make it clear what time and date you were listening so we can also check back and listen to the output.

If you are concerned we are not meeting the conditions of our licence make sure you outline in which area.

Make sure your grievance/grievances are clear and concise.

Always provide your contact details so we can get back in touch with you. Please be assured we will treat all complaints very seriously.

We will endeavour to answer all written complaints within two weeks with our findings.
